Improvement Program Discretionary Funding grant. In July 2018, the FAA announced an additional \$1 billion in discretionary funding. PIE is seeking \$11,110,095 in grant funding to be used for the design and construction of new general aviation taxiways and ramps that will connect the airfield to future Airco site development. PIE is conducting an environmental assessment for future aviation and non-aviation redevelopment of the Airco parcel that requires FAA approval. PIE will be ready to begin infrastructure improvements following the completion of this assessment at the end of 2018. The funding included in the FY18								
estimate and FY19 budget is to cover the costs of the environmental assessment. Federal funding for this portion of project 000034A is not included tentative FY19 CIP budget until FY23 and FY24. Funding for the project was moved out to the later years because PIE was waiting for discretionary funding following the environmental assessment. With the additional discretionary funding authorized by the FAA, the project can move forward sooner if PIE is awarded this grant. The estimated cost of the project has increased by \$7.3M due to rising construction costs. If PIE is awarded the grant, the FY20 budget submittal will be updated to include these grant funds.
