NOTES: This new award will provide \$140,750.00 (inclusive of a \$10,000.00 increase above our request of \$130,750.00) in ongoing funding to support the expansion of SUD treatment services by hiring two additional staff (1 counselor, 1 substance use care coordinator) to seek client engagement at point of care within a hospital partner facility to connect with community based services upon discharge from the Emergency Department or inpatient hospitalization. An additional \$175,000.00 (inclusive of a \$25,000.00 increase above our request of \$150,000.00), one-time funding supplement, will be used to purchase technology supplies for the two proposed staff positions and additional medications to increase the capacity of the HCH's current medication assisted treatment (MAT) program.
