NOTES: This Amendment revises the agreement scope to integrate the existing County program Forensic Focused Outreach into the RRIM and Pilot with PEMHS assuming direct fiscal and program oversight. In Fiscal Year 2017 (FY2017), PEMHS reached capacity and went into over-flow status on 228 days. A review of admissions indicated that many individuals could potentially be placed in a less restrictive environment with the appropriate community supports. In order to reduce ongoing demand for costly crisis beds and to better connect clients to appropriate community services, PEMHS has moved forward with the implementation of RRIM to improve the local system of care. Focusing on front-end interventions and community stabilization, the RRIM reduces the number of publically funded beds from 59 beds to 45 beds and shifts resources to intake and diversion.
