**Qualification Requirements:**

Per statute, the membership makeup is a tri-party board: one-third must be democratically selected representatives of low income individuals and families who reside in the geographic area; the second one-third must be elected officials holding office at the time of their selection or their representatives; and the final group is composed of business, industry, labor, religious, law enforcement, education, or other major groups and interest in the community served. The Board of County Commissioners appoints two public sector members. Seats are for a five year term but requires annual reappointment.
