In construction phase FDOT requires both County and contractors to indemnify FDOT. Contractor must name FDOT as additional insured and provide certificate of insurance. Contractor's must be compliant with minimum FDOT requirements as shown in insurance section of Grant Agreement in addition to limits set by County.
