# 6A5. Case CW 18-24 - City of Belleair Bluffs



#### **SUMMARY**

From: Residential Low Medium

Retail & Services To: Area: 0.30 acre m.o.l. Location: 2726 Bayway Avenue

This proposed amendment is submitted by the City of Belleair Bluffs and seeks to amend a site totaling approximately 0.30 acre from Residential Low Medium (used to depict those areas that are primarily wellsuited for suburban, low density or moderately dense residential uses at a maximum density of 10 dwelling units per acre) to Retail & Services (used to depict areas developed with a mix of businesses that provide for the shopping and personal service needs of the community or region, provide for employment opportunities and accommodate target employment uses, and may include residential uses as part of the mix of uses). This amendment qualifies as a Type A subthreshold amendment because it is less than five acres in size and meets the balancing criteria.

The subject property is being occupied by a single family home. If approved, this amendment will be consistent with the City of Belleair Bluffs' Comprehensive Plan.

#### **FINDINGS**

Staff submits the following findings in support of the recommendation for approval:

- A. The Retail & Services category is appropriate for the proposed use of the property, and is consistent with the criteria for utilization of this category.
- B. The proposed amendment either does not involve, or will not significantly impact, the remaining relevant countywide considerations.
