Date/Time/Comments: 08/06/2018 Spoke Tim Clark (PM) Project consists of Intersection improvements including removal of pedestrian bridge. Roadway to be widened and new sidewalk built along side of road. Permits are attached from ACOE, FDEP, and SWFWMD. The project is partially funded by City of Clearwater that requires the contractor to agree to indemnify both the County and the City and agree to name both as additional insured. The agreement is not funded by FDOT. JPA previously reviewed 17-1818A attached. CR previously reviewed and approved by VEH under 2 week review. Copy is attached.

NOTES: The work for the County includes the removal of an existing footbridge. Installation of box culvert, paving, installation of sidewalk to replace bridge, and installation of new signals. The primary work to be performed on behalf of the City is the replacement, relocation, and/or adjustment of 500 linear feet of sixteen inch (16") water main, and approximately 500 linear feet of eight inch (8") and six inch (6") water main that are in conflict with the proposed intersection improvements. Directional boring will be utilized.
