Dear Mr. Burton,

We were very encouraged by our meeting with you today and look forward to continuing to work together in the future on our shared goal of creating more affordable housing for families making less than 80% of Area Median Income.

We are heartened by your commitment to quickly address problems with the latest draft of the ordinance to express the intent of the county related to allocation of the 8.3% of Penny Funds for Affordable Housing and Economic Development. We are hopeful that we can have an ordinance ready for the County Commissioners to review and approve at their second meeting in February.

We thank you for your commitment to put the following language back into the ordinance in order to clearly express the intent of the County Commission regarding Penny for Pinellas funds spent on Affordable housing.

- 1) Penny for Pinellas affordable housing money should be spent on one of the following options:
  - a. 60% of the units in a building are market-rate, and the other 40% of the units go to families making 60% AMI or less
  - b. All units in a building go to families making less than 80% of Area Median Income
  - c. Properties for other income levels may be included if data shows those income levels have the greatest need for affordable housing

As we discussed in our meeting. This is in line with the County's current practices regarding spending of Penny for Pinellas housing funds. Additionally option a) provides opportunities to create mixed income housing for a variety of income levels and option c) gives the county some flexibility to fund other projects.

We also thank you for agreeing to reinsert the following language into the ordinance

2) It is the goal of the county commission to spend 10% of the Penny for Pinellas affordable housing money every year.

Based on the history of what happened with the affordable housing money in the last Penny cycle it is important for the community to see that everyone is committed to trying to spend affordable housing money each year. Also we know that developers will not submit affordable housing applications to the County until county staff issue Requests For Proposals (RFPs) and so it is important that staff have clear goals to guide their work to elicit proposals from developers.

The current draft of the ordinance does include the most important language

3) It is the County's goal to allocate at least 4.15% of said 8.3% of net proceeds for affordable housing.

It is important that the ordinance be written in such a way as to provide guidance to the whole review committee. Since the County Commission has to approve whatever the review committee ultimately recommends it would make sense for the County Commission to give the review committee some guidance as to its goals and desires before the committee digs into the details. We think it is great that the ordinance instructs the County's three representatives to follow these guidelines but we want to make sure that the ordinance also informs the whole committee of the County Commission's goals.

Your staff asked us if we would be satisfied if the county passes a resolution instead of an ordinance. An ordinance is our preference because we know it is stronger than a resolution. If you feel that it is important that this be a resolution rather than an ordinance then we ask that you also include these three main points in the County's Comprehensive Plan to ensure that each year they provide a direct guide to county staff.

Lastly, in our meeting Ms. Chelsea Hardy asked if we would be comfortable including money spent on infrastructure for affordable housing as part of the 4.15%. Our answer is that we do not want infrastructure expenditures counted as part of the 4.15% for affordable housing. The 4.15% should be spent to acquire property to be used for affordable housing. The other 95.75% of Penny for Pinellas funds are available to be used for infrastructure improvements. We have been assured by numerous housing staff that the housing needs in Pinellas are so great that we will have no trouble spending upwards of \$100 million for acquiring land for affordable housing if that money is made available. Housing staff have also shown that there are numerous other pots of money that can be paired with Penny Funds to help developers pay for rehabbing or building on properties acquired with Penny Funding.

Lastly, we are asking you to personally clarify what role Kathryn Driver as head of the Housing Finance Authority will play in spending the 4.15% for affordable housing. At this point she is the only staff person in the county who has strong track record of knowing how to effectively spend Penny for Pinellas money for affordable housing. Our fear is that the review committee could devolve into staff people fighting over funding for projects in their own communities and we could lose her expertise in putting together high quality projects that benefit our whole county.

We look forward to hearing back from you later this week or early next week with a new draft ordinance for us to review.


