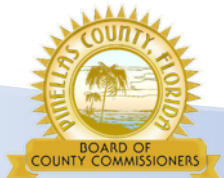

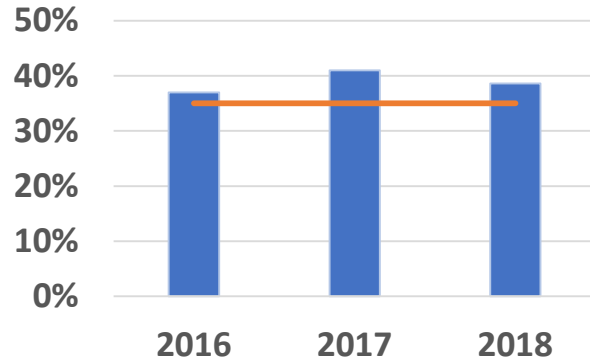

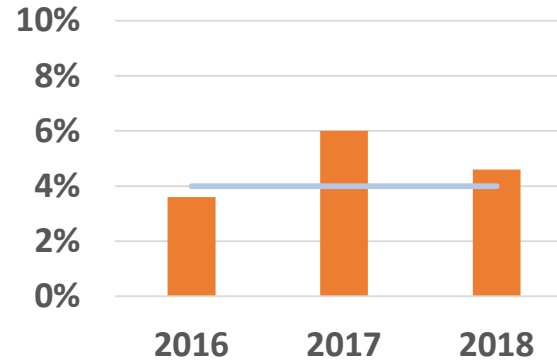

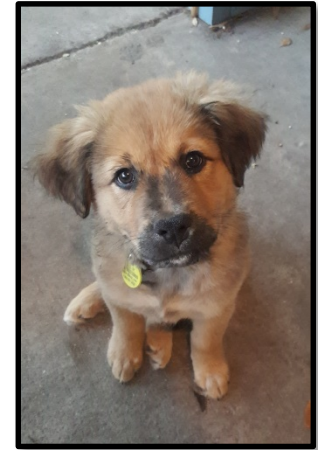


■ Dogs — National Avg Dog

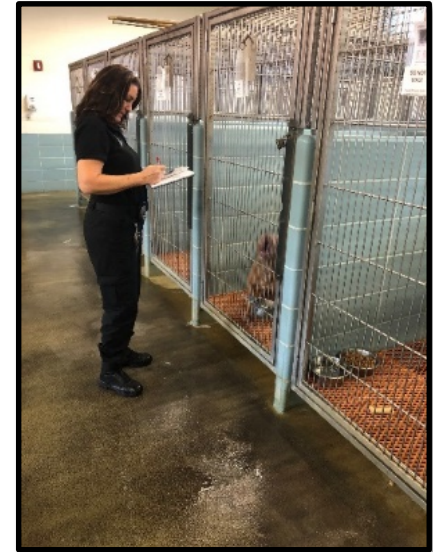


- **Hurricane Michael Response – Bay County**

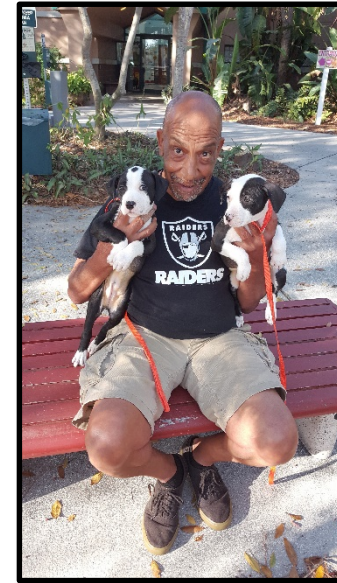
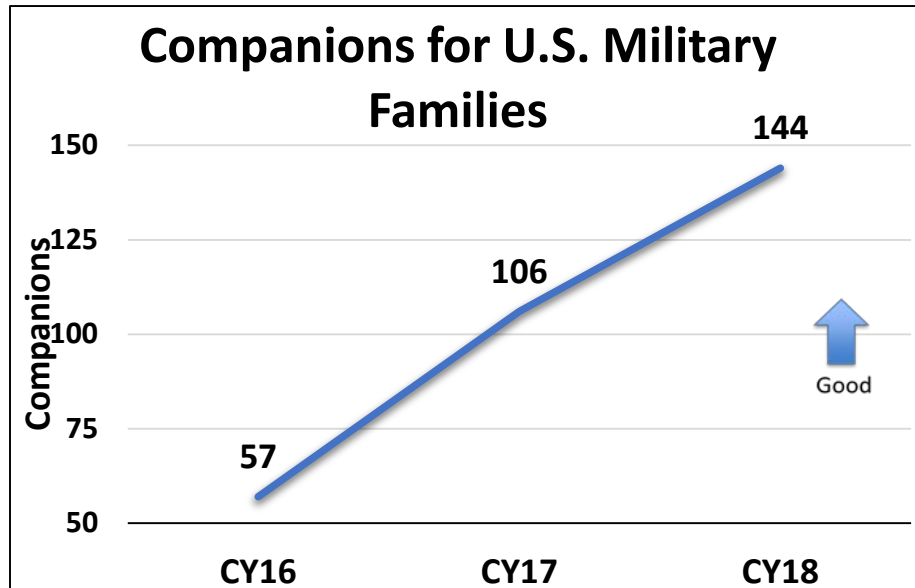
