

- 1.1M+ calls processed annually
- Dispatch all Fire/EMS
- Pinellas County Sheriff's Office (PCSO) Dispatch co-location
- 911 equipment & networks for six centers







- Generated \$57.6M in ambulance revenue
- Over 180K claims to Medicare, Medicaid, Insurance carriers
- Administered the Pinellas County Sunstar FirstCare Membership plan to 2,758 enrolled members
- Secured \$423,280 through participation in the Public Emergency Medical Transportation Program (PEMT)
