Dear Janet,

Thanks for being at the ground breaking ceremony Commissioner Long! Here is a little bit about the civic building:

- Construction will begin soon, like in the next couple of weeks for a 2500-2600 square foot joint use building.
- Construction should be completed by February/March 2019.
- The building will be owned and operated by SPC.
- In turn we (SPC) will lease office space to the Seminole Chamber of Commerce.
- The building will also serve as a welcome center for visitors to the city of Seminole.
- Additionally, we've carved out meeting space in the building that will serve multiple purposes:
 - 1) Civic clubs like Kiwanis, Rotary etc. can meet there at no charge (scheduling of room is based on availability)
 - 2) The space will also allow for classes to be taught (up to 40 people/students can fit in this particular room) (scheduling of room is based on availability)
 - 3) County staff such as code enforcement, building inspectors etc. will also have opportunities to utilize the building for meetings (scheduling of room is based on availability)
- Lastly, in addition to the \$500,000 the Lurie's provided, we (the college) also received \$130,000 from so many different people and businesses, including the county.
