
















Crossings/Intersections Project Spotlights

62nd Avenue N & Youth Park



54th Avenue N & 37th Street N



52nd Avenue N & Duval Park Boulevard



- Add entry to park
- Add mid-block crossing along corridor
- Add landscaping

- Improve placement and visibility of Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon
- High emphasis crosswalk
- Signal evaluation

- Realign driveway
- Improve access to Neri Park for pedestrians and bicyclists

Neri Park



- Add Bicycle & Pedestrian Facilities
- Add lighting

- Create Connection to Sawgrass Lake Park
- Add Lighting

- Formalize Connection
- Add lighting

Improve access to the park for pedestrians and bicyclists











46th Avenue N – 49th Street N to 37th Street N



- Add sidewalk (both sides)
- Northside trail/widewalk
- Trail connection/crossing to Neri Park
- Enhance railroad crossing
- Add lighting
- Resurface roadway



ROW: Varies (approximately 60')
Two travel lanes (10' each)
Viewpoint: Looking west



28th Street N – 38th Avenue N to 62nd Avenue N

- Improve sidewalks & fill gaps
- Add bicycle facilities
- Bus stop enhancements
- Add & enhance pedestrian crossings
- Add lighting
- Potential for on-street parking north of 54th Avenue N













54th Avenue N – 49th Street N to 34th Street N

Points of Consensus:

- Crossing improvements
- Intersection improvements
- Wider sidewalks
- Reduced speed
- Lighting

TBD in Preliminary Engineering:

Lane configuration east of RR tracks

CRASHES ON THE CORRIDOR 2012-2016

- 108 injuries & 4 fatalities on 1.25-mile stretch
- 23 crashes involved a pedestrian (8) or bicyclist (15)
- **22 crashes** involving motorcyclists
