Board Policy Guidelines: Fees

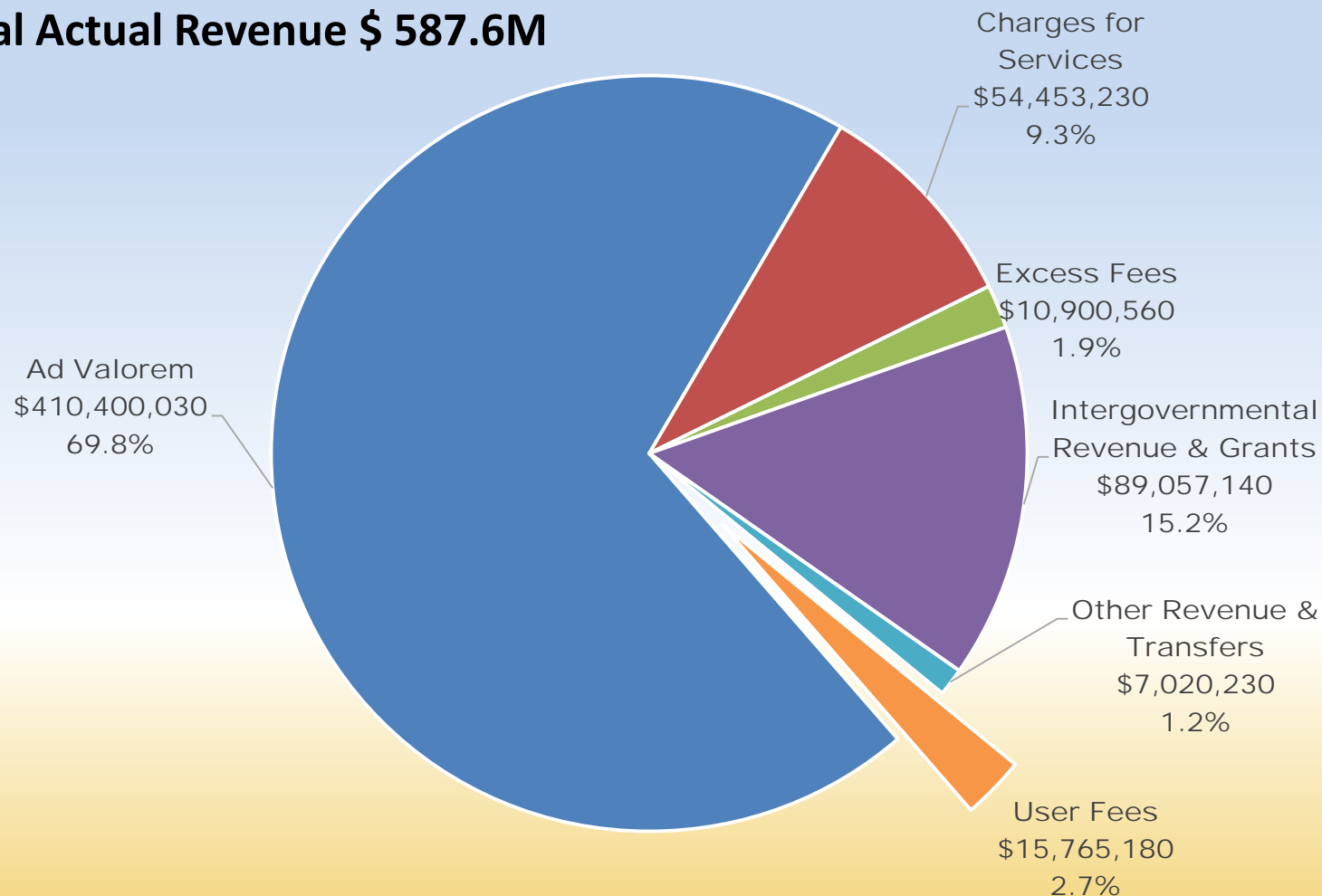
Align the beneficiary of a service to the funding level for that service.

- Economic Impact / Affordability

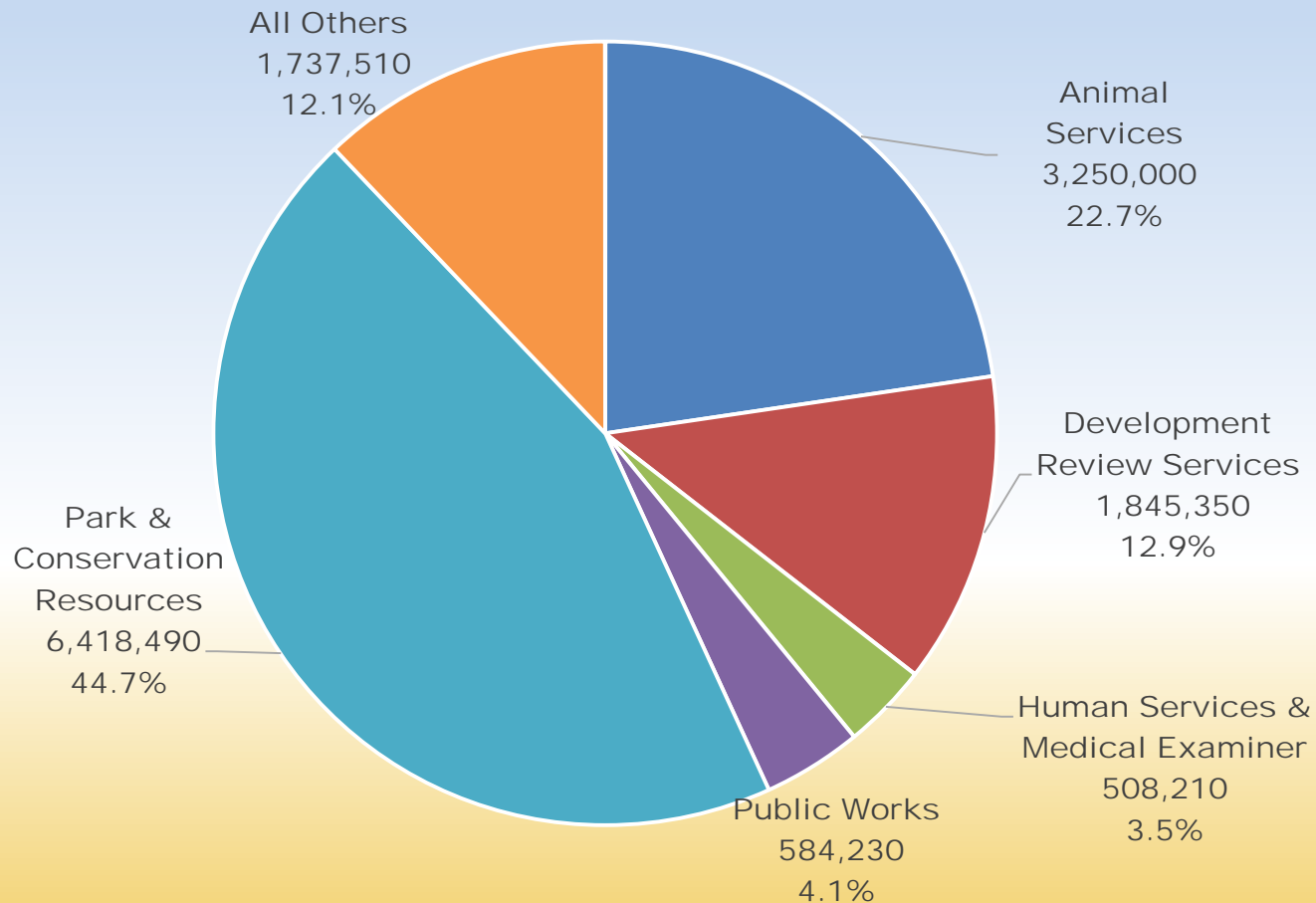
FY18 GENERAL FUND REVENUE BY CATEGORY

Building Services Fund

- 10% Increase in Existing Fees

Solid Waste Revenue and Operating Fund

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Utilities Rate Overview

Board approved a four-year plan of rate increases on May 21, 2019 for FY20-FY23

■ Water System

- Retail – increase base charges for larger meter sizes
 - No increase to base charges for $\frac{3}{4}$ " meter or water usage charge
- Wholesale – 1.0% increase for water usage charges

■ Sewer System

- Retail and Wholesale – 9.5% increase to base and usage charges

■ Reclaimed Water System

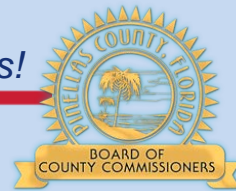
- Establish base charge for metered customers (includes 15k gallons per month)
- Align user fees for all customers over 4-year rate plan
- Increase level of cost recovery and align pricing with large users

Other Funds

Water Revenue and Operating Fund (Fund 4031)

- **Delete From Existing Fees – Remove Leak Meter**
(No Fiscal Impact)

All fees, administrative and text changes, and scrivener corrections will be included in the FY20 User Fee Schedule presented in the Proposed Budget.
