# SECOND AMENDMENT TO SPECIFIC PERFORMANCE AGREEMENT WITH PINELLAS SUNCOAST TRANSIT AUTHORITY (CD17PSTA)

THIS AMENDMENT (AMENDMENT) is made and entered into this <u>13</u> day of <u>May</u>, 2019, by and between **Pinellas County** (**COUNTY**), a political subdivision of the State of Florida, having its principal office at 315 Court Street, Clearwater, Florida 33756, and **Pinellas Suncoast Transit Authority (AUTHORITY)**, an independent special district, having its principal office at 3201 Scherer Drive, St. Petersburg, Florida 33716:

#### WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the **COUNTY** entered into Specific Performance Agreement **CD17PSTA** (AGREEMENT) with **AUTHORITY** to provide, through the Pinellas County Planning Department (DEPARTMENT), **\$68,310.00** (**Sixty-Eight Thousand, Three Hundred Ten and NO/100 Dollars)** in Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds for the purchase and installation or replacement of bus shelters in the publicly dedicated rights-of-way in the Central Lealman, East Lealman and Tarpon Springs Target Areas and the Greater Ridgecrest Neighborhood Revitalization Strategy Area; and

WHEREAS, the **COUNTY** and the **AUTHORITY** executed a First Amendment to Specific Performance Agreement CD17PSTA to amend the project description and extend the term of the AGREEMENT; and

WHEREAS, one identified proposed bus shelter stop in the AGREEMENT is no longer feasible due to a road widening project and the **AUTHORITY** has proposed an alternate bus shelter stop; and

WHEREAS, design, permitting and construction of the new alternate stop will require additional time beyond the AGREEMENT's current expiration date; and

WHEREAS, the **AUTHORITY** will not otherwise be able to complete the project before the AGREEMENT expiration date; and

WHEREAS, the **AUTHORITY** has requested and the **COUNTY** has agreed to amend the project description and extend the term of the AGREEMENT to **September 30, 2019**.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants, agreements, understandings, undertakings, representations and promises, and intending to be legally bound thereby, the parties do hereby covenant and agree that the recitals set forth above are true and accurate and are hereby incorporated in and made a part of this AMENDMENT, and further covenant and agree as follows:

1. That Section 1. PROJECT DESCRIPTION, subsection a), shall be deleted and replaced with the following:

### 1. PROJECT DESCRIPTION

a) **AUTHORITY** shall contract for the purchase and installation or replacement of bus shelters, including ADA landing pads, shelter pads, trash cans, bike racks, map boards, benches and photovoltaic lighting

systems; hereinafter referred to as "PROJECT." **COUNTY** shall provide funding for PROJECT to **AUTHORITY** under this AGREEMENT for bus shelters in the publicly dedicated rights-of-way at the following locations:

## **Central and East Lealman Target Areas**

- Stop ID# 2278 49<sup>th</sup> Street North and 42<sup>nd</sup> Avenue North (east side of 49<sup>th</sup> St)
- Stop ID# 2290 49<sup>th</sup> Street North and 42<sup>nd</sup> Avenue North (west side of 49<sup>th</sup> St)
- Stop ID# 2585 49<sup>th</sup> Street North and 58<sup>th</sup> Avenue North (west side of 49<sup>th</sup> St)
- Stop ID# 2527 28<sup>th</sup> Street North and 54<sup>th</sup> Avenue North (east side of 28<sup>th</sup> St)
- Stop ID# 2642 27<sup>th</sup> Street North and 62<sup>nd</sup> Avenue North (north side of 62<sup>nd</sup>)

### Greater Ridgecrest Neighborhood Revitalization Strategy Area

- Stop ID# 3748 Ulmerton Road and 119<sup>th</sup> Street (south side of Ulmerton Rd)
- Stop ID# 3629 Ulmerton Road and 130<sup>th</sup> Avenue (south east side of Ulmerton Rd)

#### **Tarpon Springs Target Area**

- Stop ID# 6524 US HWY 19 North and Federal Place (west side of US 19)
- 2. That Section 4. TERM OF AGREEMENT; EFFECTIVE DATE, shall be deleted and replaced with the following:

## 4. TERM OF AGREEMENT; EFFECTIVE DATE

This AGREEMENT shall become valid and binding upon proper execution by the parties hereto. This AGREEMENT is effective on **October 1, 2017**, and unless terminated pursuant to the terms herein, shall continue in full force and effect until **September 30, 2019**, or until **COUNTY'S** full and complete disbursement of funding to **AUTHORITY**, whichever comes first. **AUTHORITY** may use the funds provided herein to cover eligible Project expenses incurred by the **AUTHORITY** between **October 1, 2017** and **September 30, 2019**.

3. That Section 6. SPECIFIC GRANT INFORMATION subsection (e), shall be deleted and replaced with the following:

### 6. SPECIFIC GRANT INFORMATION

(e)	Subaward Period of Performance Start and End Date	October 1, 2017 –
		September 30, 2019

4. Except as modified by this AMENDMENT, the remaining terms and conditions of the AGREEMENT shall remain in full force and effect.
