## NOTICE OF PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE COUNTYWIDE PLAN FOR PINELLAS COUNTY

The Pinellas Planning Council (PPC) will conduct a public hearing to consider recommending the passage of an ordinance to amend the Countywide Plan for Pinellas County, as set forth below:

The Pinellas Planning Council (PPC) public hearing will be held on Wednesday, July 10, 2019 at 1:00 P.M., or as soon thereafter as the agenda permits, in the Board of County Commissioners Assembly Room, 5th Floor, Pinellas County Courthouse, 315 Court Street, Clearwater, Florida.

The Pinellas County Board of County Commissioners, acting in its Countywide Planning Authority (CPA), will subsequently hold two public hearings to be scheduled by the CPA, and advertised separately, subsequent to receiving the recommendation of the PPC.

The proposed ordinance to amend the Countywide Rules is titled:

ORDINANCE AMENDING PINELLAS COUNTY AN ORDINANCE NO. 15-30, AS AMENDED, TO UPDATE THE COUNTYWIDE PLAN STRATEGIES AND COUNTYWIDE RULES; DELETING THE TRANSIT-ORIENTED LAND USE VISION MAP; ADOPTING THE LAND USE STRATEGY MAP; MODIFYING STANDARDS AND REQUIREMENTS FOR THE ACTIVITY CENTER AND MULTIMODAL CORRIDOR RECLASSIFYING CATEGORIES: SPECIAL CENTERS AND SPECIAL CORRIDORS; CREATING THE PLANNED REDEVELOPMENT DISTRICT CATEGORY; MODIFYING THE TIERED AMENDMENT PROCESS; PROVIDING FOR NEW LOCAL DENSITY AND INTENSITY BONUSES; ADDING AND MODIFYING DEFINITIONS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

This is an ordinance to amend the Countywide Plan to update the adoption, amendment, and use of the Activity Center and Multimodal Corridor categories, add a new Planned Redevelopment District category, provide for new locally defined density and/or intensity bonuses, and update definitions.

The PPC will make a recommendation to the CPA and the CPA will subsequently schedule two public hearings to consider approval, modification, or denial of the proposed amendment to the Countywide Rules in accordance with Chapter 2012-245, Laws of Florida, as amended.
