





What is Health in All Policies?


Health in All Policies (HiAP) is a collaborative approach to improving the health of all people by incorporating health considerations into decision-making across sectors and policy areas



Why Health in All Policies?

Complex health and equity problems that cannot be addressed by one sector or organization

- 12% of Pinellas adults self-report poor mental health
- Ranked 25th in Health Outcomes (of 67 Florida counties)

Health in All Policies Resolution

To further health and equity in Pinellas County, the Planning Department recommends the passage of a resolution in support of a Health in All Policies approach to government operations
