Dear Mr. Burton,

Thank you and your Commissioners for allowing me to present information about the opportunity to bring the Cross Bay Ferry back for another season of service. As a follow-up to the Commission meeting, I am providing the below and attached information for the County's consideration. I hope that you and the Board find the information useful as final funding and the Interlocal Agreement is considered.

You may recall from the presentation that during the 2018-2019 seasonal service, over 52,000 passengers rode the Cross Bay Ferry. I have received updated information which more accurately reflects the billing zip code of the ticket purchasers, which is as follows:

47% were from Hillsborough40% were from Pinellas6% were from Florida, but not Pinellas or Hillsborough7% of ticket purchasers were from outside of Florida

The existing agreement between the City of St. Petersburg and HMS Ferries has two one-year renewal options and as such would be utilized to provide the 2019-2020 seasonal service. Per that agreement, the cost to provide the ferry service is \$942,126. Per the agreement, HMS accepts the risk for the first \$200,000 in revenue by capping the maximum government subsidy at \$742,126. The maximum government cost is shared equally with the four local governments (\$149,182 each) after being supplemented with remaining funds from the Florida Department of Transportation grant. Based on the estimated cost of \$942,126, HMS would retain revenues over \$200,000 and less than \$400,000 as profit. If revenues exceed \$400,000 then HMS and the partner governments would split the revenues on an equal share. Based on the last season, we don't anticipate exceeding the \$400,000 threshold as revenues were just under \$300,000.

Finally, in speaking with HMS this week related to marketing and customer feedback, HMS has agreed to conduct additional on-board surveys periodically during the 2019-2020 season, in addition to the end-of-season survey it has routinely conducted. The City and HMS will also continue to look for ways to establish partnerships with organizations, including the CVB/VSPC,

that continues to make our residents and visitors aware of the opportunity to use the Cross Bay Ferry as a means to travel and explore Tampa Bay.
