Agreement has indemnity language holding each party responsible for their actions. The agreement also has 768.28 language. Reviewed from prior agreement 19-1138A. Used same limits as expiring contract. Limits are already inserted in to agreements.

NOTES: The EMS Authority and the Cities of St. Petersburg and St. Pete Beach now desire to enter into a new ALS First Responder Agreement with an initial five-year term beginning on October 1, 2019 and ending on September 30, 2024. This new agreement will also have the option for one additional five-year extension. This agreement will provide the following enhancements which will be implemented over two fiscal years through mid-year funding in FY19-20 and full funding in FY20-21:

- Adds a Rescue Captain to serve the City of St. Petersburg.
- Increases partial funding for St. Pete Beach to a full FTE for EMS Coordination
