

By the end of 2020, **the goal is to add12 statutes** to complete the 100-foot Circle of Heroes.



Diving in on a new memorial for veterans I Editorial

The Circle of Heroes underwater memorial about 10 miles off the coast of Clearwater is a wonderful addition to Tampa Bay's efforts to honor the military veterans who have served this nation so well.

It's a unique veterans memorial, a certain tourist draw and a free attraction - if you can dive down more than 40 feet into the Gulf of Mexico. The Circle of Heroes underwater memorial about 10 miles off the coast of Clearwater was dedicated this week and it is a wonderful addition to Tampa Bay's efforts to honor the military veterans who have served this nation so well. Much of the credit goes to former U.S. Rep. David Jolly, who embraced a relative's vision and led the fundraising effort to make it a reality.



The result: The Circle of Heroes, which ultimately will feature two dozen 6-foot concrete statues depicting members of the military and arranged in a 100-foot circle. Half of the statues, nine men and three women featuring five military branches, have been positioned and were shown off this week. The rest are expected to be added next year.


