RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE AND THE CLERK TO ATTEST AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (DEPARTMENT) AND PINELLAS COUNTY (COUNTY) FOR FUNDING OF DESIGN ACTIVITIES ASSOCIATED WITH THE STARKEY ROAD CORRIDOR SIDEWALK PROJECT FROM ULMERTON ROAD / STATE ROAD (SR) 688 TO EAST BAY DRIVE / STATE ROAD (SR) 686 THROUGH THE LOCAL AGENCY PROGRAM (LAP) AGREEMENT, DEPARTMENT FINANCIAL PROJECT NUMBER 437736 2 38 01.

WHEREAS, the DEPARTMENT has the authority to enter into this agreement with the COUNTY pursuant to Section 339.12, Florida Statutes to provide federal aid funds for projects or project phases that are included in the DEPARTMENT's adopted work program; and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY has certified to the DEPARTMENT that it has met the eligibility requirements of said Section 339.12, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY has requested funding from the DEPARTMENT through the LAP for the Starkey Road Corridor Sidewalk Project, from Ulmerton Road (SR 688) to East Bay Drive (SR 686) to design a five (5) foot concrete sidewalk (approximately 9,300 linear feet) on both sides of the roadway, driveway modifications and curb ramp upgrades to complete sidewalk gaps; and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY will be reimbursed from the DEPARTMENT for expenses incurred during the agreement time period that are directly related to the project; and

WHEREAS, the Starkey Road Corridor Sidewalk Project from Ulmerton Road (SR 688) to East Bay Drive (SR 686) has been awarded funding for engineering design services and activities; and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY is responsible for engineering design services and activities; and

WHEREAS, it is required that execution of a formal Agreement for the transfer of funds for the above activities be entered into between the DEPARTMENT and the appropriate COUNTY officials.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Pinellas County, Florida, duly assembled this 11th day of February, 2020 authorizes the Chairman to execute and the Clerk to attest the LAP Agreement with the DEPARTMENT for funding of design activities associated with the Starkey Road Corridor Sidewalk Project from Ulmerton Road (SR 688) to East Bay Drive (SR 686).
