

This annexation is in compliance with both the Interlocal Agreement, dated July 2000, between Largo, Pinellas County and Pinellas Park, and the Settlement Agreement between all the Cities of Pinellas County, Florida, for the Resolution of Issues related to the Charter Review Committee, dated May 2007.

Enclosed is a copy of the Notice of Public Hearing, for Ordinance No. 2020-25, that will be published in the Tampa Bay Times, Largo Times, not in the Classified section on Friday, March 6, 2020 and on Friday, March 27, 2020. First reading/Public Hearing for the Ordinance is scheduled for March 17, 2020. The second Reading/Public Hearing is scheduled for April 7, 2020. Meetings are held at the Largo City Hall, 201 Highland Avenue, at 6:00pm.


