### Description & Comments

The Human Services Department requests approval by the County Administrator for the first amendment of a no cost extension to the grant award from the University of Baltimore's Fiscal Year 2019 Competitive Subaward for Combating Opioid Overdose through Community-level Intervention Grant. The funding will be utilized to implement the Homeless Overdose Mitigation & Engagement (HOME) program. This first amendment no cost extension will provide additional time for HOME efforts to continue by extending the availability of program funds beyond the initial award period, ending November 30, 2020, through August 31, 2021.

This item is not consistent with the development of the FY20 or FY21 budget. This item was included in resolution number 20-25 approved by the Board on April 7, 2020. This item was not considered during the development of the FY21 budget since this time extension was not anticipated. FY20 estimates and FY21 budget requests will be amended to include this agreement in the FY21 Adopted Budget.
