W-9 Issue with Pinellas CARES Small Business Grant	<p>money is reported as income for tax purposes requiring a W-9. The W-9 requires a certification/signature regarding perjury. The grant requires and is very adamant in the directions that the info on Line 1 and 2 of the required W-9 and the info on Line 1 and 2 of the application be exactly the same in order to receive a check. If I was a Sole Proprietor or a LLC (Partnership, C-Corp, or S-Corp) this would not be an issue I think. The problem is I am a Single Member LLC. For tax purposes, I file my taxes like a Sole Proprietor, but I am an LLC (but not a Partnership, C Corp or S Corp). So when I complete the W-9 per the W-9 instructions, my name goes on Line 1 as is on my 1040 and my business name/dba goes on Line 2. And the W-9 has the usual certification and signature regarding perjury.</p> <p>So my info will read:</p> <p>Line 1 Robynne Swanson Line 2 Robynne's Daisy, LLC dba Red Hot Tiki</p> <p>The issue appears when I get to the CARES application. Line 1 requires my legal business name and to match Line 1 on the W-9. Line 2 requires my DBA and to match with Line 2 of my W-9. In my case completed as requested on the application it would look like this:</p> <p>Line 1 Robynne's Daisy, LLC Line 2 Red Hot Tiki</p> <p>After a short discussion with someone at the Economic Development Board I was told to change my W-9 to reflect what was required on the CARES application in order to get the check. I have a problem with this. I am sure they did not realize they were inadvertently asking me to falsify the document when clearly no one took into consideration Single Member LLCs when creating the grant requirements. I was also told that I could not do this below on the CARES application because it would read Robynne Swanson dba Robynne's Daisy, LLC dba Red Hot Tiki. And Robynne Swanson is not my legal business name.</p> <p>Line 1 Robynne Swanson Line 2 Robynne's Daisy, LLC dba Red Hot Tiki</p> <p>I am concerned because I will probably be assigned a reviewer this week. I do not want to be put in the situation where I have to choose between the much needed grant money or lie. And dealing with the "rules are the rules" attitude without seeking to understand the issue is frustrating. I have no desire to cause anyone including myself trouble. I would just like a remedy.</p> <p>Please help. I want to do the right thing as a citizen and a small business owner.
