I had an opportunity to watch the hearing about this matter so I understand that safety as your main concern.

It was pretty obvious that the boating members of your board understood that there isn't much to fear. The depiction of boats on a sandbar as some sort of danger is not accurate. Limiting boats to the high current area in the channel where the boaters would swim next to their vehicles is more dangerous. There's a reason lagoons are called a safe harbor and our children use the lagoon for just that. Your reply to Mary requested some "suggestions" of a compromise to combat this false narrative of safety. I would recommend a compromise allowing a no boat area NW of the north parking lot that would allow swimmers to access the sand bar safely. This is the small south east lagoon attached to the big lagoon. A warning sign stating this is a boating area enter at your own risk would give swimmers a heads up and reduce potential liability. I truly feel the swimmers who venture that far north would see the boats and already have an idea that there are boats here. Drawing a red line around the entire lagoon is a huge overreach that angered thousands of Pinellas citizens. Please help us get this reversed with some type of compromise. The small lagoon closest to the north beach would make a great crossing and infant swimming area.
