Airport

Purpose

The St. Pete-Clearwater International Airport (PIE) is responsible for operating and maintaining the runways, taxiways, buildings, equipment, and vehicles belonging to the County Airport, and providing aviation fire protection services. The airport provides a full range of high-quality customer, aviation, and facility services to support the transportation and commerce infrastructure used by airlines, passengers, airport customers, tenants, the Transportation Security Administration, and the U.S. Customs and Border Protection. The annual \$1B+ economic impact of the airport is associated with the tenants/businesses located at the airport and on-airport construction projects, as well as the spending from visitors arriving via the airport to the Tampa Bay area. The airport is entirely self-supporting by user fees, leases and concessions, and federal and state grant revenue. No Pinellas County property tax revenue is used for the operations of PIE. PIE contributes primarily to the Board of County Commissioners' Strategic Plan goal to Foster Continual Economic Growth and Vitality.
