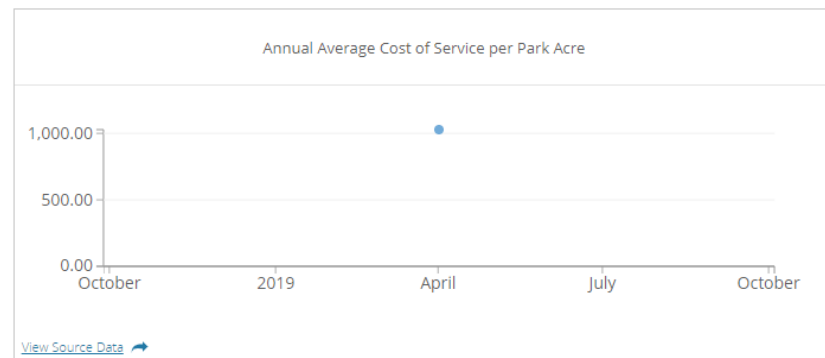
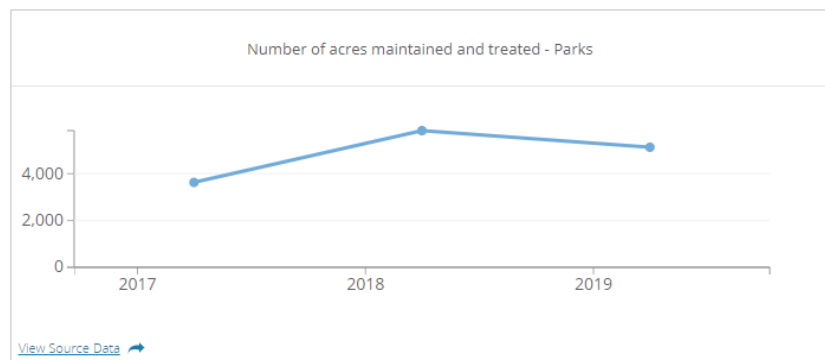


Parks and Conservation Resources

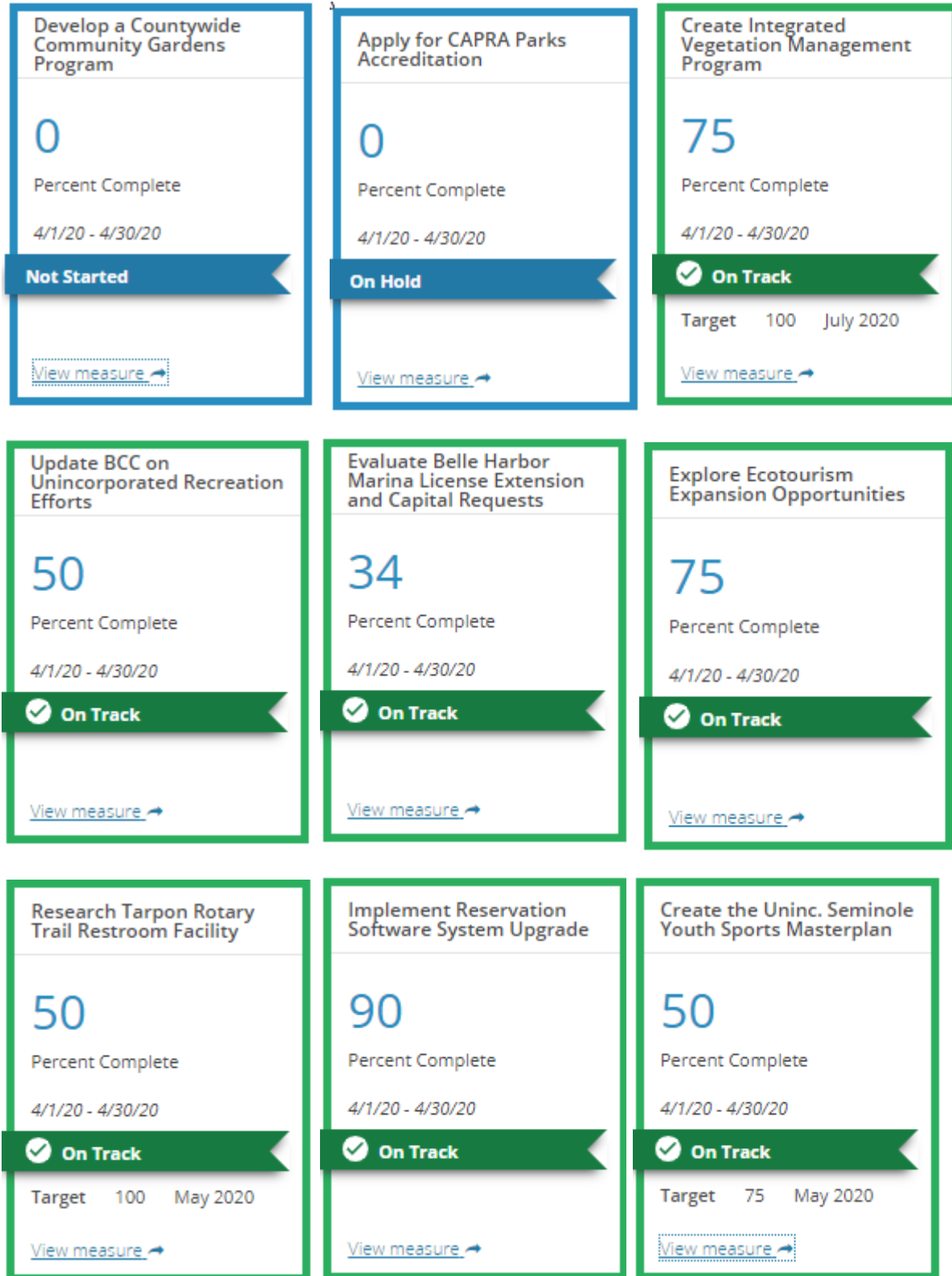
