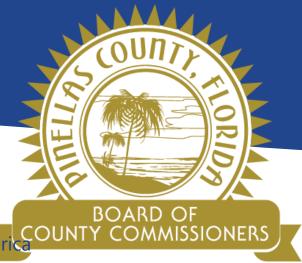

COVID-19 Impacts

- Revenue
 - FY20 Estimate- Decrease of \$12.4M
 - Half-Cent Sales Tax and Revenue Sharing 15.5% decrease from original projections
 - Reduction is mostly offset by \$11.9M received from FEMA for Hurricane Irma
 - FY21 Decrease of \$4.0M
 - Half-Cent Sales Tax and Revenue Sharing 5.5% decrease
 - General Fund Balanced with > 15% Reserve for FY21

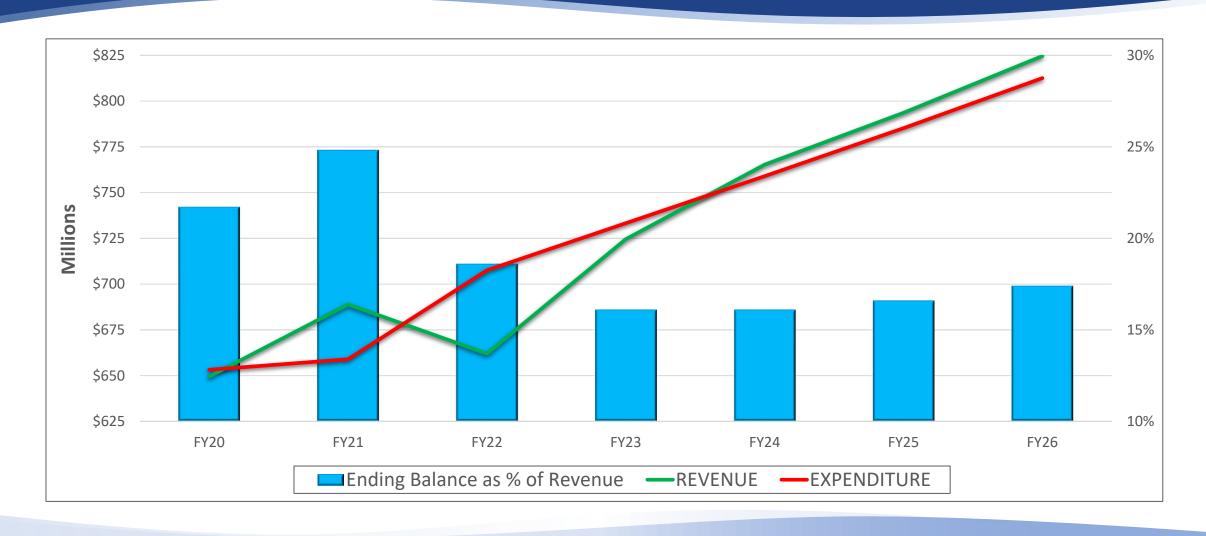
General Fund



- COVID-19 Impacts
 - Expenditures
 - FY20 Estimate \$8.0M in COVID-19 expenses
 - Most Significant Impact to the General Fund Revenue expected in FY22
 - Taxable values affected in FY22
 - Forecast projects 6% decrease in FY22 with slow recovery for the remainder of the forecast period

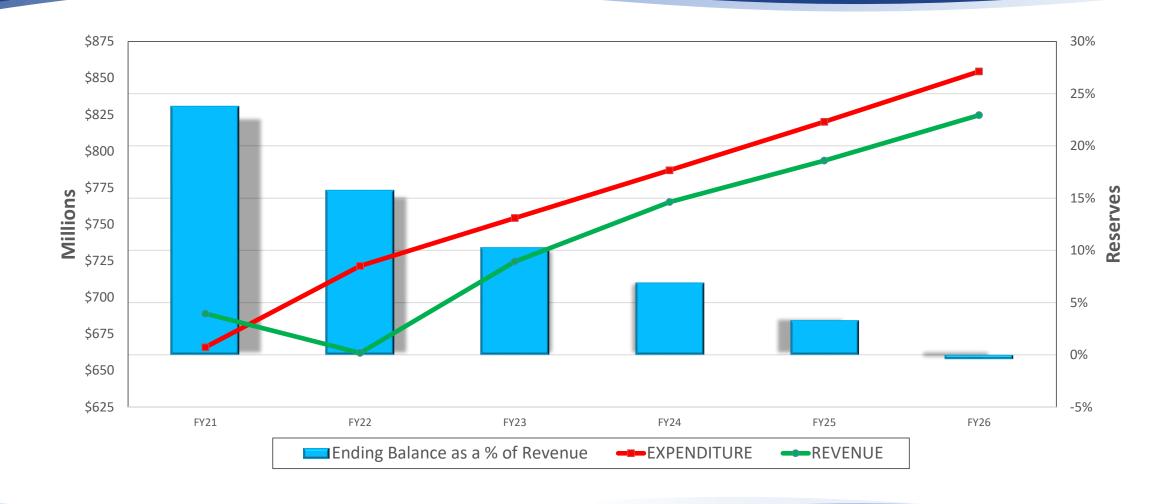
General Fund Forecast FY20-FY26

Airport Fund



- COVID-19 Impacts
 - \$8.7M in CARES Act Funding to Mitigate COVID-19 Impacts below
 - Revenue Impact (excluding CARES Act)
 - FY20 Estimate \$6.0M in revenue losses
 - FY21- \$4.5M decrease in revenue

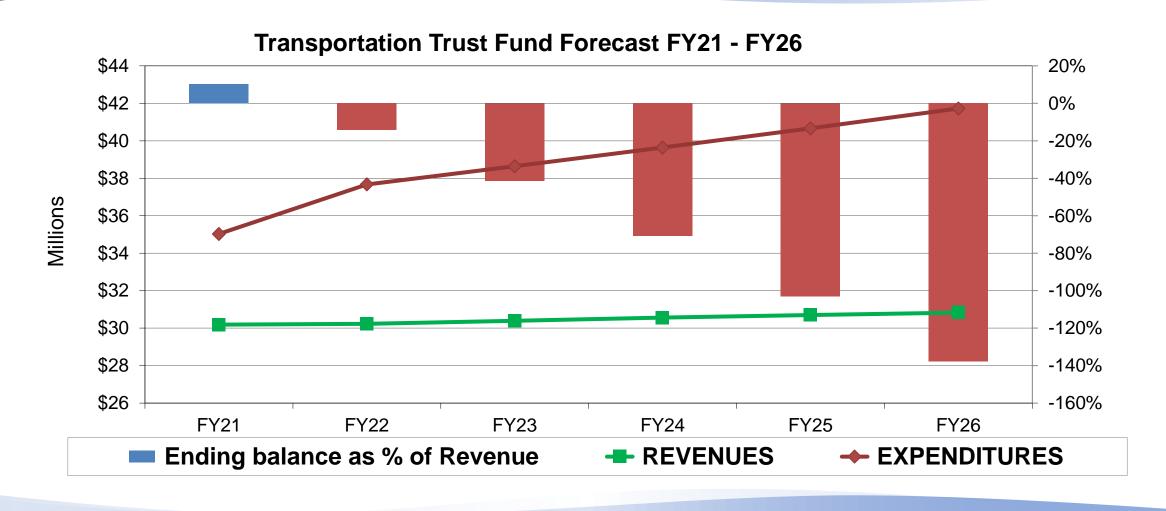

 - FY20 Estimate: Decrease of 10% from original projection
 - FY21: Decrease of 8% from original projection
 - Reduction in Transfers from Other Funds
 - Tourist Development Tax Fund
 - Transportation Trust Fund
