

 - The vacation will add this portion of property to the tax rolls.








- General Location Map




Infrastructure

- County departments were queried and have no objections to the vacation request.
- Utilities and Public Works Department have requested the retention of a drainage and utility easement over the entire vacated area.
- Pursuant to §336, Florida State Statues, any person or persons may petition to vacate, abandon, discontinue and close any existing public or private street, alleyway, road, highway, or other place used for travel, or any portion thereof, other than a state or federal highway, and to renounce or disclaim any right of the county and the public in and to any land in connection therewith.



- Adjacent affected property owners were noticed of the intent to vacate.

- Staff review completed February 26, 2020
- Letters sent to adjacent property owners June 3, 2020
- Public hearing June 23, 2020 (Deferred)
- Public hearing July 21, 2020
