### Description & Comments

The Human Services Department requests approval of the Addendums to the agreements with the Department of Health (DOH) and Operation Par Inc. (PAR) for the Health Care for the Homeless (HCH) program.

These 2 Addendums provide supplemental COVID-19 funding from the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) to enhance services and capacity of the HCH Program. Funding will allow HCH to provide additional staffing and supplies to respond to COVID-19, including behavioral health and substance use services.

Funding to support these agreements is consistent with the development of the FY20 estimate and FY21 budget. Budget resolution 20-42 was approved by the Board on 05/05/20 to supplement the Fiscal Year 2020 Budget in various funds for unanticipated revenue from the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act, the Coronavirus Preparedness and Response Supplemental Appropriations Act, and the Tampa Bay Resiliency Fund.
