> The planning effort will leverage the recent state-approved Local Mitigation Strategy and an on-going vulnerability assessment that is evaluating future tidal and storm surge inundation. Pinellas County has invested in producing exposure mapping for coastal concerns (SLR and storm surge) ripe for asset-based risk assessments. Risk assessment quantifies the likelihood of the asset being exposed to the hazard (e.g., flooding) and the consequences if the asset is exposed. Pinellas County is currently assessing the monetized risk values for a select number of roadways. As proposed in this application, this approach can be expanded to include all potential stressors for exposed asset types or community assets already identified in the County. The specific funding ask of this application is too help pay for the generation of building and facility profiles through ground survey, combined with that assessment of precipitation-based flooding potential now and into the future.
