(CHC) for services and support related to Coronavirus Disease-2019 (COVID-19) testing, contract tracing, management, and mitigation.

The DOH agreement is effective from July 7, 2020 through December 30, 2020. Compensation is set for a not to exceed amount of \$1,459,270.00 for the contract period, with monthly reimbursement of invoiced expenses. Electronic submission of invoices and retroactive reimbursement of expenses is authorized.

The Community Health Centers of Pinellas agreement is effective from July 7, 2020 through December 30, 2020. Compensation is set for a not to exceed amount of \$2,295,309.00 for the contract period, with monthly reimbursement of invoiced expenses. Electronic submission of invoices and retroactive reimbursement of expenses is authorized.

This item is not consistent with the development of the FY20 or FY21 budget. On May 5th, the Board adopted resolution 20-42 supplementing the Fiscal Year 2020 (FY20) Budget for unanticipated revenue from the CARES Act. A budget amendment for FY21 will be brought forward separately, if needed.
