### **Tentative FY21 Budget Summary**



### • \$2,712,399,580 Total Budget

- \$61.8M (3.4%) Decrease, excluding Reserves and CARES Act
- Reserves Increase \$179.2M (27.0%) multi-year strategy
- BCC Total Budget \$106.1M (9.0%) Decrease, excluding reserves
- BCC General Fund \$1.5M (0.8%) Increase
- Lowest debt per capita among urban Florida counties

## **Changes from FY21 Proposed Budget**

- Reduce millages for Six (6) Fire Districts
- Additional funds to support Supervisor of Elections staffing agreement with Clerk of the Circuit Court
- Additional funds for Behavioral Health Initiative
- Additional funds for EMS Enhancements for Largo Squad 38 and Redington Beach Medic Unit
- Elimination of SHIP funds due to State Budget
- Increased reserve levels in various operating funds

## **Changes from FY21 Proposed Budget**



- Reduced County Share of State Mandated Juvenile
  Detention Costs
- Recognize CARES funds to be expended in FY21
- Updated User Fees for Solid Waste and Building & Development Review Services

## **Changes from FY21 Proposed Budget**

- Various grant awards and contracts for services
- Amend timing and scope of projects within 6-year Capital Improvement Plan
- Updated FY20 Estimates and Carry Forward to FY21
- Technical adjustments and corrections







### • No proposed increases

- General Fund 5.2755 mills (unchanged since FY14)
- EMS 0.9158 mills (unchanged since FY14)
- Health Department 0.0835 mills (increased in FY18)
- MSTU 2.0857 mills (unchanged since FY09)
- Unincorporated Fire Districts
  - Six Districts Decreased (Clearwater, Dunedin, Gandy, Largo, Safety Harbor, South Pasadena)
  - Six Districts Unchanged (Belleair Bluffs, High Point, Pinellas Park, Seminole, Tarpon Springs, Tierra Verde)
