Rebuild Florida CDBG-MIT Proposal

Description:

This project focuses on addressing the countywide need for additional Hurricane sheltering space. The improvements to these two sites will provide almost 800 general population or 400 special needs shelter spaces that will contribute to filling our Countywide shelter deficit. These community shelters also help serve the communities of Palm Harbor and Lealman. This project proposes energy and space improvements, exterior mitigation, roof and building hardening at the Lealman Exchange Gym & Palm Harbor Community Center.

The Palm Harbor site has recently been offered a Florida Division of Emergency Management (FDEM) grant for an engineering study that will aid in guiding any further sheltering enhancements or needs. We are working toward the same grant opportunity for the Lealman site.
