Comments Dear Board of County Commissioners, I support the continuance of the Pinellas County mask mandate. We are still in the middle of a very dangerous pandemic. As of this date, there have been over 195, 618 United States citizens who have died of the almost 7 million recorded infections. In Pinellas Co. alone, we have over 21,000 recorded infections, and over 710 reported deaths. Most suspect the actual numbers are much higher. In addition, since school has returned, the numbers of infections have increased daily. Just yesterday, there were 108 reported covid infections, and this demonstrates a consistent daily increase. Common sense makes it obvious that with schools open, numbers will increase. Dr. Fauci and others have told us this is a recipe for disaster.
