EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES ALS FIRST RESPONDER AGREEMENT AMENDMENT NO. 1

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT made this <u>6th</u> day of <u>October</u> 2020 between the CITY OF ST. PETERSBURG, a Florida municipal corporation ("Contractor") and the PINELLAS COUNTY EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES AUTHORITY, a special district ("Authority").

In consideration of the mutual benefits set forth below, the parties agree as follows:

- Contractor currently contracts with the Authority to provide Advanced Life Support (ALS) First Responder Services. The Contractor and the Authority are currently parties to a contract whereby the Contractor provides Advanced Life Support (ALS) First Responder Services for the Authority, which contract is referred to herein as the "2019 Agreement."
- Appendix A of the 2019 Agreement is hereby deleted and replaced with Amended Appendix A, which is attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference. All references in the 2019 Agreement to Appendix A shall mean Amended Appendix A.
- 3. The Authority funded and authorized ALS First Responder Units and the Annual Compensation for FY20-21, listed in Amended Appendix A attached hereto, reflect the characterization and funding for the addition of Medic 7 staffed 12 hours per day, 7 days per week.
- 4. In FY20-21, the Contractor will purchase the Medic 7 response vehicle utilizing Contractor held EMS funds previously provided by the Authority. The funding cap for this vehicle acquisition is \$100,000.
- 5. Section 701(c) of the 2019 Agreement provides for a reasonable standardized reimbursement amount for rescue units. Authority and

Contractor are transitioning from standard rescue units to rescue units with a lifetime warranty for the utility compartment which may be remounted at the end of the useful life of the chassis. Remount-able rescue units are anticipated to save significantly more over time than the additional upfront cost. Contractor and Authority agree the FY20-21 remount-able rescue unit amount is capped at \$230,000. Contractor and Authority further agree that the reimbursement amount for Rescue 5 and Rescue 10 procured in FY19-20 and scheduled for delivery in FY20-21 and vehicles procured in FY20-21 are subject to the reimbursement cap of \$230,000 to begin the transition to remount-able standardized reimbursement amount for remount-able rescue units. The Authority shall determine a reasonable standardized reimbursement amount for remount-able rescue units amount for remount-able rescue units.

Except as is otherwise set out herein, the Contractor and the Authority
agree that upon approval by the respective Boards of the Contractor
and the Authority and upon signing this First Amendment, all terms of
the 2019 Agreement will remain in full force and effect.
