- 2. Section 701(f) of the Agreement provides for an extraordinary budget increase which must be negotiated and approved prior to the beginning of the next fiscal year in the event any proposed budget submitted by the Contractor should exceed three (3%) percent of the prior Fiscal Year's budget. The Contractor's funding for FY19-20 totaled \$1,573,785 and a budget request of \$1,638,915 for FY20-21 has been submitted, resulting in an increase of 4.14% or \$65,130.
- The Authority hereby agrees to and has funded and authorized the Contractor's budget request of \$1,638,915 for FY20-21, which change is reflected on Appendix A hereto.

- 4. Except as is otherwise set out herein, the Contractor and the Authority agree that upon approval by the respective Boards of the Contractor and the Authority and upon signing this Amendment, all terms of the Agreement will remain in full force and effect.
- 5. Contractor and Authority agree that the effective date is October 1, 2020.
