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

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
PROPOSED RESOLUTION ADOPTING AN INTERLOCAL
AGREEMENT RELATED TO THE ST. PETERSBURG
INTOWN WEST COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AREA
AND REDEVELOPMENT TRUST FUND, AND THE
DELEGATION OF REDEVELOPMENT POWERS

The Pinellas County Board of County Commissioners proposes to adopt a Resolution to approve an Interlocal Agreement between the City of St. Petersburg and Pinellas County pertaining to the Intown West Community Redevelopment Area and Redevelopment Trust Fund, and delegate certain redevelopment powers to the City of St. Petersburg.

The Pinellas County Board of County Commissioners will conduct a public hearing on the proposed Resolution on **Tuesday, November 17, 2020, at 9:30 a.m. or thereafter** in the Magnolia Room at the Florida Botanical Gardens, 12520 Ulmerton Rd., Largo, FL 33774.

Interested parties may appear at the hearing and be heard regarding the proposed Resolution and Interlocal Agreement:

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PINELLAS COUNTY, FLORIDA, APPROVING AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF ST. PETERSBURG THAT AMENDS THE TIF CONTRIBUTION RATES OF THE PARTIES TO THE INTOWN WEST TRUST FUND, SPECIFIES THE PROJECTS THAT THE PHASE I TRUST FUNDS MAY BE EXPENDED ON, AND CONVEYS DELEGATION OF ALL REDEVELOPMENT POWERS TO THE CITY OF ST. PETERSBURG FOR ITS STEWARDSHIP OF THE PHASE II TRUST FUNDS FOR THE INTOWN WEST COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AREA, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

In review of the Resolution and Interlocal Agreement above, there may be modifications that arise at the public hearings and/or with other responsible parties.
