This item is for the approval of additional language to Pinellas County Ordinance, Section 02-625 - Administrative fines; costs; liens.

The additional language (paragraphs G through M, and sections 2 through 5) define the maximum aggregate lien amounts imposed by a Special Magistrate for Code Enforcement Division violations that may accure on single-family residences or non-single-family residences.

For single family residences, the aggregate amount may not exceed twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000.00), and for non-single-family residences, the aggregate amount may not exceed one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00).

The additional language also states that any hard costs or fees incurred by the County in conjunction with enforcing a Code Enforcement Division violation are not subject to the limitations described above.

There is no fiscal impact associated with the update to this ordinance.
