The Forward Pinelias public hearing will be held on Wednesday, May 8, 2019, at 1:00 P.M. or as soon thereafter as the agenda permits.

The CPA public hearing will be held on Tuesday, June 4, 2019, at 9:30 A.M.



The proposed Retail & Services category is used to depict areas developed with a mix of businesses that provide for the shopping and personal service needs of the community or region, provide for employment opportunities and accommodate target employment uses, and may include residential uses as part of the mix of uses. The current and proposed Target Employment Center category is an overlay used to depict those areas of the county that are now developed, or appropriate to be developed, in a concentrated and cohesive pattern to facilitate employment uses of countywide significance.

The recommendation by Forward Pinellas and the action of the CPA may amend the Countywide Plan Map from the existing plan category as referenced above for the amendment, or to another plan category as may be determined appropriate based on the public hearings and consistent with the Countywide Plan and procedures related thereto.

Persons are advised that, if they decide to appeal any decision made at this meeting/ hearing, they will need a record of the proceedings and, for such purpose, they may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record includes testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.
