
Adopt Resolution Accomplishing the Following:

- Finding of Blight in the North Greenwood Study Area
- Delegate Certain Redevelopment Powers to the City
- Authorize the City to Proceed with the Preparation of the North Greenwood Redevelopment Plan

Finding of Necessity Study Process

- City looked at six study areas for inclusion in the CRA
- Examined socio-economic data, crime/code statistics, and conducted fieldwork
- Preliminary conclusions analysis supported a finding of blight for Study Areas #3 and #5
- Examined the combined area consisting of Study Areas #1, #3, and #5 and concluded that the analysis also supported a finding of blight.
- Recommendation to adopt combined Study Area

Completed Steps

- Finding of Necessity (FON) Study Approved by City October 14, 2020 (Res. 20-52)
- Letter Requesting Review November 17, 2020
- County Comment Letter January 19, 2021
- Receipt of City Responses February 12, 2021
- BCC Work Session April 8, 2021


Next Steps

- BCC Consideration of the Delegation of Authority (May 11, 2021)
- City CRA Planning Process (Est. Completion 1st Quarter 2022)
- City Approval of the CRA Plan
- County Review and Consideration of the CRA Plan (Scoring Criteria/TIF Contribution)

Proposed CRA Boundary



- Total Acreage ±653.64
- Economic Impacts of Poverty At-Risk Zone
- FON identified 2 conditions of blight meets state requirements
- Taxable Value \$198,452,086
- Taxable value per acre \$303,610
- OMB developed 20-year TIF projections (2.5% growth rate)
 - Projection **\$6,247,144** total County TIF @ 95%
