The Human Services Department requests approval of five (5) Interlocal Agreements with the Public Defender's Office for the Jail Diversion Recovery Program, Juvenile Crossover Program, a youth therapist to work with Ready for Life, and an information technology (IT) position.

All five (5) Interlocal agreements are intended to be effective from October 1, 2021 through September 30, 2022. *(See tracked changes for the Jail Diversion Recovery Programs effective date changes.)* The contracts total \$1,233,220.00, the amounts for each are: Diversion and Recovery Programs (\$858,170.00), two (2) Case Managers assigned to the Juvenile Crossover Court program (\$154,860), one (1) position for the Ready for Life program (\$82,820.00), one (1) Jail Diversion case manager (\$76,600), and one full-time IT specialist (\$60,770.00). The positions being funded through these agreements are not considered to be County employees.

Appropriation to support these agreements is consistent with the development of the FY22 Tentative Budget.
