High Point Community Plan 2021



In 2021, Pinellas County formed a community advisory group to create a plan to guide improvements to the High Point neighborhood. The advisory group consisted of residents, service providers, business owners, educators, clergy and law enforcement from the area. The group developed the goals and strategies below. A community meeting and online feedback survey confirmed the advisory group's recommendations and provided additional, specific ideas. County departments will use this plan to identify projects and funding for future community improvements.





Enhance Community Connectivity
