The Human Services Department requests approval and execution by the County Administrator of the award acceptance and funding agreements with five nonprofit entities for the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant-Countywide (JAGC

Funding in an amount not to exceed \$236,358.00 is provided by JAG-C to support seven projects in Pinellas County. Six projects totaling \$136,635.80 will be administered by Human Services. One of the six projects is an internal program for grant administration totaling \$23,635.80. The Pinellas County Sheriff will administer their own project directly with FDLE having a total of \$99,722.20.

The five agreements for approval include: Alpha House of Pinellas County, Inc. (Alpha House) for a Child Abuse Prevention program (\$18,000.00), Directions for Mental Health, Inc. dba Directions for Living (Directions) for TRACE Program crisis counselor position (\$20,000.00), MORE Health, Inc. (MORE Health) for Firearm Safety & Violence Prevention training for youth (\$25,000.00), Suncoast Center, Inc. (Suncoast)for Forensic Focused Outreach case management and treatment (\$25,000.00), and WestCare GulfCoast-Florida, Inc. for Mustard Seed Inn Case Management (\$25,000.00).

All five (5) agreements are effective for a period of one (1) year, from October 1, 2021 through September 30, 2022. Requests for reimbursement will be made on a monthly basis within 15 days of the end of the month.

Appropriation to support related grant activities is consistent with the development of the FY22 tentative budget.
