The Human Services Department requests approval of the four-year grant award from the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration for the First Responders - Comprehensive Addiction and Recovery Act (FR-CARA) Grant. Approval of the delegation to the County Administrator to accept future annual continuation awards and to execute all subrecipient agreements and contracts.

The grant provides an award of \$499,999.00 per year for up to four years for a total award of \$1,999,996.00. There are no match or cost sharing requirements related to award. The FR-CARA program will work to address the County's goals to reduce opioid related deaths and connect individuals to effective treatment.

Funding to support related Grant activities is not consistent with the development of the FY22 tentative budgets for Human Services. A resolution supplementing the FY22 budget recognizing these additional funds will be brought forward separately, if needed.
