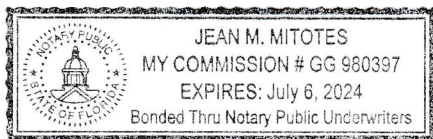

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING PROPOSED RESOLUTION STATING THE PINELLAS COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' INTENT TO USE THE STATE UNIFORM NON-AD VALOREM COLLECTION METHOD

The Pinellas County (the "County") Board of County Commissioners (the "Board") is holding a public hearing (the "Hearing") to consider adoption of a resolution (the "Resolution") stating the Board's intent to use the State Uniform Non-Ad Valorem Collection Method prescribed by F.S. §§ 197.3632, 197.3635 to levy a special assessment (the "Assessment") on Parcel I.D. Numbers' 29-29-16-38602-000-0090 and 29-29-16-38602-000-0100, which are respectively located at 1836 and 1860 Oak Street, Clearwater FL, 33760 (the "Assessed Properties"). The Resolution and Hearing satisfy the requirements of F.S. § 197.3632(3)(a). A public hearing on the proposed Resolution with virtual public participation and an on-site participation option will be held on **Tuesday, October 12, 2021 at 9:30 A.M.** or thereafter in the Magnolia Room at the Pinellas County Extension (Florida Botanical Gardens), 12520 Ulmerton Road, Largo, Florida 33774, with virtual participation utilizing Communications Media Technology (CMT) on the Zoom platform.

The Assessment is needed to fund 100% of costs for dredging the Hidden Cove II Oak Street (Stormwater) Retention Area, which is owned by the Assessed Properties (the "Project"). A map of the Assessed Properties—the boundaries of the real property subject to the Assessment—is included in this notice. If not dredged, the Hidden Cove II Oak Street Retention Area will continue to lose storage capacity, thereby degrading water quality and increasing the likelihood of localized flooding. Project completion may increase the value of the Assessed Properties. Thus, assessing the Assessed Properties for 100% of Project costs is fair, equitable, and legally justified. The County plans to levy the Assessment over a period of ten (10) years. If the Resolution is adopted, County staff will be directed to estimate the Project cost and develop the Assessment methodology. A separate public hearing is required under F.S. § 197.3632(4)(a) before the Assessment may be levied.

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PINELLAS COUNTY, FLORIDA, ELECTING TO USE THE STATE UNIFORM NON-AD VALOREM COLLECTION METHOD FOR A SPECIAL ASSESSMENT TO DREDGE THE HIDDEN COVE II OAK STREET RETENTION AREA; STATING THE NEED FOR THE ASSESSMENT; IDENTIFYING THE BOUNDARIES OF THE REAL PROPERTY SUBJECT TO THE ASSESSMENT; DIRECTING STAFF TO ESTIMATE PROJECT COST AND DEVELOP ASSESSMENT APPORTIONMENT METHODOLOGY; DIRECTING THE COUNTY ATTORNEY TO PREPARE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENTS WITH THE TAX COLLECTOR AND PROPERTY APPRAISER FOR ASSESSMENT ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS; PROVIDING FOR MAILING OF THE RESOLUTION TO THE TAX COLLECTOR, PROPERTY APPRAISER, AND STATE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

In review of the Resolution above, there may be modifications that arise at the public hearing and/or with other responsible parties.
