PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE PINELLAS COUNTY FUTURE LAND USE MAP, ZONING ATLAS AND THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN

The Pinellas County Board of County Commissioners proposes to adopt the following Ordinances and Resolutions amending the Pinellas County Future Land Use Map, Zoning Atlas and the Comprehensive Plan.

A public hearing on the Ordinances and Resolutions with virtual public participation and an on-site participation option, to be held on **Tuesday**, **October 26**, **2021 at 6:00 P.M.** or thereafter in the Magnolia Room at Pinellas County Extension (Florida Botanical Gardens), 12520 Ulmerton Road, Largo, Florida 33774, with virtual participation utilizing Communications Media Technology (CMT) on the Zoom platform.

The public hearing will be streamed live at https://youtube.com/pcctv1 and www.pinellascounty.org/TV, and broadcast on the Pinellas County cable public access channels:

An Ordinance amending the Future Land Use Map of Pinellas County, Florida by changing the Land Use designation of approximately 2.18 acres located at 1736 Winchester Road in unincorporated Largo located in Section 30, Township 29, Range 16; from Residential Suburban to Residential Low; reversing and overturning Pinellas County Resolution No. 21-27; and providing an effective date.
