Summary:

Ms. Rawlins and Mr. Holmes volunteered to serve additional two-year terms as citizen representatives on the EMS Advisory Council. Both nominees have completed the appropriate Pinellas County application for citizens being nominated to Boards, Councils and Committees.

Background Information:

The Pinellas County EMS Advisory Council was created by Chapter 80-585, Laws of Florida, and is made up of 24 members that constitute a broad spectrum of county representation.

It is the responsibility of the council to evaluate the county’s EMS system from a qualitative point of view, to review the operation of EMS on a countywide basis, to review and evaluate studies commissioned by the EMS Authority upon the Authority’s request, to make recommendations to the EMS Authority on needs, problems and opportunities relating to EMS and to carry out such other duties as may be required to ensure the delivery of good countywide EMS at a reasonable cost.
