Preliminary Surface Water Rate Resolution for the FY 2017 Surface Water Service Assessment.

Recommended Action:

Adopt the Preliminary Surface Water (SW) Rate Resolution for the FY 2017 Surface Water Service Assessment.

Summary:

This is the Preliminary Surface Water Rate Resolution for FY2017 (FY17). It establishes the Annual SW program cost for FY17 at \$20.9 million. The proposed (assessment) rate for FY17 is unchanged at \$117.74 per “equivalent residential unit” (ERU). Total estimated revenue for FY17 is \$19.6M. Based on the projected expenditures for FY16, the gap between FY17 revenue and program costs will be offset by fund balance and will allow for the necessary cash flow to cover the first two months of FY17.

Background Information:

Currently, the Surface Water Assessment is brought to the Board of County Commissioners for annual adoption through a preliminary resolution and a final public hearing to be held on September 14, 2016, at 6:00 p.m.

Fiscal Impact:

The recommended assessment of \$117.74 per ERU is unchanged from the prior fiscal year. It is estimated to generate \$19.6M to meet stormwater needs in the unincorporated area.
