The County has requested the Lealman Special Fire Control District dedicate a portion of the land as public right-of-way to bring 46th Avenue North to Pinellas County Code.

Background Information:

Pinellas County Code Section 154.126(B)4 states that roadway intersection layout shall be at the intersection of any arterial road or collector road and another street, additional right-of-way in the form of a triangle 15 feet long on each leg shall be provided on all corners. In compliance with this

ordinance, it is necessary for a portion of the land to be dedicated as public road right-of-way.
