Housing Finance Authority of Pinellas County: 2021 Annual Report on the Pinellas County Housing Trust Fund Program.

Recommended Action:

Recommend the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) receive and file the 2021 Annual Report on the Pinellas Community Housing Trust Fund Program from the Housing Finance Authority of Pinellas County.

- The BCC did not provide new funds to the Housing Trust Fund in 2021. A total of \$2,726,703
 was available, including program income and prior year carryforwards from participating
 jurisdictions.
- A total of \$347,700.52 was expended to assist 89 households (11 households were <50% AMI and 78 households were <80% AMI).
- Other accomplishments since last year's annual report include City of Clearwater produced 1
 new single-family unit; the City of Clearwater rehabilitated 3 single-family units and the City of
 St. Petersburg produced 85 new multifamily units.

An independent audit was completed for the year ending September 30, 2021, and no significant deficiencies, material weaknesses or instances of noncompliance were identified. An unqualified opinion will be issued, and the audit will be filed with the Clerk of the Court.
